RIVERSIDE CITY COUNCIL MEETING: September 17, 2018

The Riverside City Council meeting opened at 6:30 pm in City Hall with Mayor Allen Schneider requesting roll call. Council members present were: Andy Rodgers, Tom Sexton, Bob Schneider Jr., Jeanine Redlinger, and Ralph Schnoebelen.

Motion by Schnoebelen to approve the agenda, Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Schneider moved to approve the minutes from September 4th, and the expenditures pulling Schnoebelen Inc. invoice for separate vote. Second by Rodgers, passed 5-0. Schneider moved to pay Schnoebelen Inc. invoice in the amount of \$62.83. Second by Redlinger, passed 4-0 Schnoebelen abstained.

Kathy Lindhorst addressed Council about "no passing zone" on Hwy 22 through downtown.

Schnoebelen moved to appoint Edgar McGuire to the Planning and Zoning Committee to fill vacancy until December, 2020. Second by Redlinger, passed 5-0.

Redlinger moved to open Public Hearing for the Northern Heights development agreement at 6:42 pm. Second by Schneider, passed 5-0.

Chris Kirkwood gave her opinion, against the development agreement, to the Council. There were no other written or oral responses. Schneider moved to close Public Hearing at 6:47 pm. Second by Schnoebelen, passed 5-0.

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m. in City Hall.
- 2. Roll call showed the following members present:

3. Commission members reviewed the final plat for Galileo Drive. The city has inquiries already coming in from people wanting to purchase lots as soon as the street is completed.

- 4. The Commission discussed the number and placement of lots. There was some confusion over an area marked Lot 'A' and another area marked Outlot 'A,. Lot 'A' is an easement along Tupelo and Outlot 'A' is at the SE corner near the school that will be reserved for storm water management. Work on the street is progressing and concrete should soon be poured. Rogerson moved and Musser seconded to send this plat to the council recommending approval. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the motion.
- 5. The Commission unanimously voted to approve the P&Z minutes from the July 23, 2018, meeting, noting the correction to the spelling of Mike Welch's name.
- 6. Rogerson moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:15 p.m., unanimously approved. The next scheduled meeting will be held Monday, September 24, at 6 p.m. There are already issues being discussed that will likely make this meeting necessary.

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. in City Hall.
- 2. Roll call showed all members present:

- 3. The Commission was called to order and unanimously voted to approve the P&Z minutes from the August 27, 2018, meeting.
- 4. The Commission reviewed a preliminary plat for the Northern Growth Development. This area will be served by water and sewer lines that were put in for Cherry Lane and Galileo. The lots on the plat provide for single family dwellings, duplexes and multi-family units that require R2 and R3 zoning. R2 zoning allows for 70-foot lot widths for single family units. The water retention basis will be owned and maintained by the city. There is a possible future issue of creating an island of the parcel owned by Kurt Schnoebelen, but Pottorf pointed out that the 80/20 rule provides a way to force annexation to avoid this, if necessary. Neither Apex nor Jeff Edberg has contacted the property owner to advise them of this. Several members felt the family should at least be notified of this situation. Robinson moved and Rogerson seconded to recommend approval of annexation of both parcels to the city council. This motion passed unanimously. Rogerson moved and McGuire seconded to recommend zoning Parcel 1 as R2 and Parcel 2 as R3 to the city council. This motion also passed unanimously.
- 5. The preliminary plan for the duplex that Jason Shalla proposes to build on Washington Street was discussed. It includes two rental units (top and bottom) of approximately 920 square feet with no basement. There will be parking in front and sidewalks on two sides. Jason plans to put in 6-8 parking spaces; four are required. Kirkwood moved and Rogerson seconded to recommend approval of the preliminary plan to the city council. There was a question raised whether the lot was big enough by code to be buildable. If not, it will still have to be referred to the Board of Adjustment by the city council.
- 6. A map and preliminary plans were reviewed for building a six-plex at 111 Knisel Street by TWRVR Properties, where another four-plex unit already exists. All of the units will be rentals and the new building requires R3 zoning; the property is currently R2. After some discussion concerning traffic and the property location on the highway, Rogerson moved and Kirkwood seconded to recommend approval to zone the entire parcel (including the current building) R3 to the city council. This motion passed unanimously (Musser left at 6:45 pm to attend another meeting).
- 7. A preliminary plan and photo of proposed zero lot line units to be built by Don Prybil was reviewed by the commission. This property is already annexed and zoned R2 and lies east of the Travel Mart at the corner of Highway 22 and Vine Avenue. The county has a gravel road up to this parcel that is currently blocked off. Prybil explained that there will be ten buildings with two streets so that they can all be walk-out units and they will be owned individually, not rented. Pottorf pointed out that each unit needs to front to a public street conforming to city code, as planned here. Rogerson

moved and Cloyed seconded to send the preliminary proposal to city council recommending approval of the development concept. This motion passed unanimously.

- 8. The preliminary plat for the River North subdivision on Vine Avenue in Washington County planned by Todd Hahn was reviewed. Discussion about possible future annexation, costs for utilities, and lot sizes followed. The issue for Planning and Zoning is confined to waiving the city's review of this development because it lies within two miles of Riverside city limits, but this waiver does not preclude any future annexation agreement that might be reached. Kirkwood moved and Robinson seconded to recommend to city council to waive review of the Hahn subdivision. This motion passed unanimously.
- 9. Rogerson moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:20 p.m., unanimously approved. The next scheduled meeting will be held Monday, October 1/1, at 6 p.m.

The subbase below curb and gutter on both St. Mary's Street (6" modified subbase) and Highway 22 (6" special backfill) was inadvertently omitted from the plan quantities. The subbase below curb and gutter along Highway 22 is changed to special backfill at the request of the Iowa DOT. This subbase is included in the portion of work the Iowa DOT is contributing toward.

No bid item for silt fence of filter sock was included in the contract and recent rains required additional erosion control measures beyond intake protection.

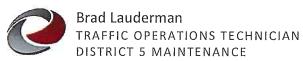
In looking at google earth imagery 9/13 there appears to be a sign posted at the St. entrance. Is this still in place? If so we may start with Red Flags on it (need to start somewhere). The City could add one to have it on both sides of the street installed at a slight angle to catch the view of mainline. Most vehicles would not see this sign as they navigate the corner, however you would get the argument that it was too late after traffic made the turn. Currently we have an Elementary School sign about 130' west of the intersection. We like to have the sign spacing a min. 3 x speed limit = 105' with the other signs in this area it is difficult we may just need to wiggle a sign in there close to the intersection.

We can change it to "NOT A THROUGH STREET" if that's what the School / City wants. See attached. I think "DEAD END" is easier to read and understand.

Yes, we can add flags if you want.

The weight restrictions are up to the City since it is a city street. They will need to figure out if that is practical nor not. If the school gets supplies delivered by semi-trucks, the weight restrictions may not be a good idea. "weight restrictions" this would affect all vehicles, however most School buses weigh about 13 ton, Concrete Trucks loaded weigh 35 tons, empty 15 ton. Depending on what delivery trucks deliver to the school this could affect, I think this would be very difficult to maintain.
