#### Becky-

I am writing to express concern with the City of Riverside's voluntary annexation of the Roetlin Yeggy Farms, LLC between Tulip Avenue and Tupelo Boulevard north of Riverside. As I understand it, this annexation is at the request of Yeggy-Roetlin Farms, LLC and Apex Development Group, LLC for a future mixed and multi-family residential development. While I have no issues with the development occurring and I am grateful for the foresight and planning the developers and City have put into this project to encourage growth within the City of Riverside, I do have concerns with how the roads on the east and west side of this annexation will be maintained.

My department is responsible for maintaining the County's roads. To fund those maintenance operations, we receive a portion of the property tax paid be every parcel in the County and we receive a portion of the state gas tax, based on the classification and number of miles of road under our jurisdiction. Since these stretches of road will fall in the City of Riverside, once the annexation is complete, my department would no longer be receiving funding to maintain them. So, as part of my responsibility to the Board and citizens of Washington County, my department will no longer be responsible for maintaining those stretches of road after the annexation is completed. With that said, I will leave it up to the City Council and the Washington County Board of Supervisors to determine if they would like to enter into a 28E agreement that would spell out how those roads may continue to be maintained by Washington County, at least until they are paved. This type of discussion is something I believe needs to happen despite this specific annexation, as there are other stretches of road along the City's fringes the County is assisting with maintenance.

As part of this annexation, I am requesting the City of Riverside specifically notify the Washington County Secondary Roads Department when the annexation is finalized.

What all do we have for this meeting?

I have a pay request for J&L I will send on Wednesday. Are the Northern Heights items ready to go? Is there anything you need from me for them?

Is there anything on the Tupelo and SRTS project we need to discuss? Do we need to talk about that intersection again?

See attached exhibit. Sorry it is kind of messy but I tried to highlight the important stuff. I would like to talk about sidewalk alignment once more if we have time for that. I show the sidewalk (in pink) angled out toward the street (edge of pavement/back of curb in orange) through the two driveways where the garages are close to the existing sidewalk. I stayed 5' from the back of curb, which is similar to the way Buckeye is per our discussion at the work session. The one garage has only about 17 feet between the sidewalk and the garage at the north end. Otherwise the other dimensions are all more than 20' and a car can park between the sidewalk and garage without blocking the sidewalk.

The other thing in the exhibit is there is a gravel parking area shown in yellow. In past projects we have eliminated these and encouraged parking on the street. Will parking be allowed on this street? If not, do we want to try and replace this gravel parking area somehow?

Let me know if there is anything else I need to be providing for this meeting.


