RIVERSIDE CITY COUNCIL MEETING: Monday, November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022

The Riverside City Council meeting opened at 6:00 pm at City Hall with Mayor Allen Schneider requesting roll call. Council members present: Tom Sexton, Edgar McGuire, Lois Schneider, Kevin Kiene, and Kevin Mills.

Motion by Schneider, second by Mills to approve agenda. Passed 5-0.

Motion made by Kiene, second by McGuire to approve consent agenda including 10-17-22 minutes, and 11-07-22 expenditures, pulling McGuire mileage expense for separate vote. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Sexton, second by Kiene to pay McGuire mileage expense of \$40.50. Passed 4-0 McGuire abstained.

Toby Hancock, Riverside Fire Dept. presented call report to date. EMS monitor purchase will be on a future agenda.

Brian Boelk, Axiom Consultants, gave project updates on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Water and Wastewater Plant repairs, Railroad Park, Country Line Estates development, and sewer repair on St. Mary's street.

Motion by McGuire, second by Mills to repair sewer line under sidewalk on St. Mary's Street. Passed 5-0.

Motion by Kiene, second by Schneider to pass Resolution #2022-107, approving Final Acceptance from Apex Construction for the Northern Heights Subdivision water detention basin. Passed 5-0.

Motion by Sexton, second by McGuire to pass Resolution #2022-108, to set the date for Public Hearing for estimated costs of repairs to the Wastewater Treatment Plant on November 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:00 p.m. in City Hall. Passed 5-0.

Motion by McGuire, second by Kiene, to adopt Ordinance 2022-109, providing for the division of taxes levied on taxable property in the Northern Heights Housing Urban Renewal Area, and to waive  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  readings. Passed 5-0.

Administrator Yancey reported on sidewalk at 700 Ash Street. Council will include sidewalks in the Capital Projects work session.

Yancey informed City Council that FEMA deigned grant application for a generator at City Hall. Schneider asked about proper procedure for voiding Resolutions.

Mayor set dates for 6:00 p.m. work sessions, November 14<sup>th</sup> for Nuisance Abatement-Staffing needs, and November 28<sup>th</sup> for Capital Projects.

Admin Yancey presented letter of retirement from City Government effective December 31, 2022. Sexton moved, second by McGuire not to accept resignation letter at this time. Passed 3-2, Mills and Schneider opposed. McGuire moved, second by Kiene to have City Attorney advise City Council on submitted recordings. Passed 3-2. Mills and Schneider opposed.

Motion by Schneider, second by Sexton to accept resignation letter from Drake Hotz, maintenance worker, effective January 3, 2023. Passed 5-0.

McGuire moved, second by Sexton to adjourn at 7:57 p.m. Passed 5-0.
